Collection of your Personal Information

Use of your Personal Information

Tracking User Behavior

Automatically Collected Information

Information about your computer hardware and software may be automatically collected by NewsUSA. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring website addresses. Use of Cookies
